Flood Repair Dockside Work

Dear Commissioners:

Two bids were received in response to Official Notice 679 for Flood Repair Dockside Work on the South Harbor Tract. The bid results are summarized on the attached sheet.

The low bidder, Michels Construction, of Brownsville, WI, has performed satisfactorily on similar work for the Port. Staff has reviewed Michels' bid and finds it has met the requirements of the bid documents. The Contractor has committed to 28% SBE utilization.

This project is in response to the remaining January 2020 flood damage and is being funded (80%) through a Wisconsin Department of Transportation Harbor Assistance Program grant. Sufficient funds for the project are available in the Board's Accounts.

Staff recommends that the Board accept the bid and award Contract 679 to Michels Construction for its bid of bid items 1 through 4 for a total price of \$179,942. As work is completed, the Contractor will be paid the unit price bid for all work authorized and completed satisfactorily. The award is subject to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation's concurrence, as required by the grant agreement.
